Slideshow Content

- ___/5 Begins with a quote that catches the audience’s attention (1 slide)
- ___/10 Summary of the movie—brief intro, climax, and resolution (3–4 slides)
- ___/5 Explanation of why you chose to research this narrative (2 slides)
- ___/5 Thought-provoking question that frames the inquiry (1 slide)
- ___/20 Comparison of at least four points in the movie and the real story (4–6 slides)
- ___/5 Summary of the plot of the real story, including brief introduction, climax, and resolution (3–4 slides)
- ___/5 Analysis—does the real story dampen the movie’s appeal? Why or why not? (2–3 slides)
- ___/10 Conclusion provides your answer to the inquiry (1–2 sides)
- ___/10 Research draws on at least five sources, including the movie, at least one book, and one online source

Slideshow Format

- ___/5 Slideshow contains 20 slides and one reference slide
- ___/5 Each slide automatically advances after 20 seconds
- ___/10 Slides contain only images—no words—with the possible exception of a quote on the introductory slide.
- ___/10 Reference slide at the end includes citations for the sources.

Presentation

- ___/5 Presenter made eye contact with the audience throughout the presentation.
- ___/5 Presenter projected his or her voice, used appropriate voice inflections to add emotion to the presentation, and avoided sounding monotone.
- ___/5 Notecards served as a guide but not a crutch during the presentation.
- ___/10 Presenter submitted notecards or notes containing the text of the presentation.
