## Appendix 15.4. Experiential Homework Assignment

This homework assignment is designed to prepare students for writing the Cultural Connections Research Essay. If feasible, it makes a good experiential complement to in-class lessons.

## Follow these instructions:

Attend a baseball or softball game. We will discuss your observations in class on [specify date that gives students plenty of time to complete the assignment]. You may attend a major league game if you like, but you certainly do not have to. You may attend a Little League or Knothole game, a minor league game, a church or recreational league game, a high school game, or a local college game. Check team and school websites for schedules.

Answer the following questions in paragraph form. Remember to proofread your work.

- 1. What game did you attend? Tell us the details: date, teams, place, etc.
- 2. What seems particularly "American" about baseball? Use your observations of the crowd, the setting, the coaches/manager and players, and anything else you notice.
- 3. Observe any traditions or rituals performed before, during, and after the event. Describe them and point out how they contribute to the sport's connection to American culture.
- 4. Follow the course of the game. Describe any drama that unfolds. What are you likely to remember from this game?
- 5. Finally, sum up and tell us why, based on your experience, you think baseball is America's national pastime.
